short walk

45 minutes approx

Enjoy a gentle, level stroll through the local countryside. Discover the context of the land, catch views of Iron Age forts, and learn about the historical significance of lynchets - medieval farming terraces that shape the landscape even today.

explorers walk

80 minutes approx

Venture up Battlesbury Hillfort - an archaeological site dating back to the Late Bronze Age. Take in stunning views of Middlehill (also known as Starr Hill), crowned by a prominent Bronze Age barrow. Learn about the rivetments, ancient longhouse locations, and the nearby settlements of Middleton. Hear the curious tales of 1960s UFO sightings that made Starr Hill a local legend.

panorama walk

120 minutes approx

Embark on a breathtaking tour of the Warminster Skyline. Walk along the edges of Salisbury Plain and enjoy sweeping views from Battlesbury Camp and Scratchbury Hill - both dramatic Iron Age hillforts with evidence of Bronze Age and Roman activity. Spot the distant silhouette of Cley Hill, another iconic hillfort. Marvel at the impressive lynchets, widely considered some of Wiltshire's finest. Conclude with a climb up Middlehill, where a Bowl Barrow marks the summit.
